Q.	Where can the video mock-up be viewed at leisure?

Q.	One of the problems is that the feedback form will only take 2000 words and there's no way to upload a PDF or Word doc.
A.	Please complete the feedback form and provide your contact details. We will get back to you with any further information you require and can explain how you can send us documents or more detailed information.

Q.	Why has the consultation taken place at a time when we can't access our AM or use the Welsh Government Petition site for the 6 weeks prior to the Senedd elections?
A.	To clarify, the publication of the draft Orders forms part of a statutory process where there is an objection period where any individuals or organisations can object, support or give their representations regarding the draft Orders and Environmental Statement for the scheme. It is not a consultation. Although all objections should be received by the Welsh Government no later than the 7 th May 2021, the objection period only forms part of the process. If you contact us directly we can forward your details onto the appropriate person in the Welsh Government, who can answer your question fully.
Q.	What mitigation is being put in to stop people using the two villages as a rat run?
A.	The scheme incorporates traffic calming measures which would be installed at certain locations in Dwygyfylchi. These would discourage people from using the Conwy Old Road - Treforris Road - Glan Yr Afon Road route through Dwygyfylchi as a rat run. The design of these measures are being developed in liaison with Conwy County Borough Council. The scheme will also provide new signage for both Dwygyfylchi and Penmaenmawr.
Q.	Is there not a Welsh Govt email address for the Orders Dept?

Q.	No-one has answered the questions that Mike Gilbert forwarded to various people at Ramboll 2 weeks ago, so I don't expect to get a response.

A.	We have received a number of questions and objections which we are currently addressing. All correspondence has been logged and any that raise concerns are being treated as objections until the individual or organisation advises us otherwise. We will contact you as soon as possible about any specific issues raised.
Q.	Why do you say that the roundabout junction is dangerous? Your collision data doesn't agree with that statement. There were only 6 accidents at the A55 roundabout at Penmaenmawr 2012-2016
A.	In context, the likelihood of an accident occurring at either Junctions 15 and/or 16 roundabout is more likely than elsewhere on the A55. Our traffic specialist can give a full response if you leave your details.
Q.	This information is in Environmental Statement, Volume 3c Appendices Chapters 7-18. The junction is no higher than other junctions in Conwy. I have the data.
